## Reflective Response on Bitter Sweet

Bitter Sweet is a short play, written during my participation in the Creative Writing Workshop with playwright Carlos Morton. The play zooms in on the life of a low-middle class couple of young adults who live in Thessaloniki in the years of the socio-economic crisis that has recently hit Greece. It explores how economic predicament, unemployment, remnants of patriarchical views and rapid social developments influence interpersonal, gender and family relations. Bitter Sweet is, mainly, a piece of melodrama, as it revolves around a hero and a heroine who initially experience perils and dilemmas, having at the same time to confront a 'villain', until they manage to tackle difficulties and carve a bright future. Naturalistic elements are also evident in the play, as it depicts the harsh realities its working-class characters face in contemporary Greek society and the characters' simple, conversational language recreates the impression of reality for the audience. Lastly, the strong presence of romance combined with a bit of humor render the play an amusing love story.
